A minimum charge for gardens of One Pound, and a minimum of Five Shillings for each garden where the water is laid on to gardens; also a charge of Two Shillings and Sixpence per annum will be made where water is not laid on, but consumers utilise the water by carrying in vessels. Water for cows and horses shall not be less than One Shilling and Sixpence, nor more than Two Shillings, per head per annum, and for a large number of cattle or horses a special arrangement may be made.

3. For steam-engines a fee of Sixpence for each charge; and for each load of water of 100 gallons from the hydrant, Sixpence.

4. For irrigation, fountains, public baths, watering stock, according to Section 41 of 59 Victoria, No. 54."

5. Where cattle are depastured on any land used for grazing purposes only, for which land the ordinary water rate is charged and paid, there shall be allowed one head of neat cattle, one horse, or five sheep per acre on such land without any extra charge. Parties exercising this privilege will be required to provide a ball-tap for their watering-troughs.

6. Water used for irrigation purposes shall in all cases be delivered by a hose, with nozzle not more than $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch attached to the tap delivering such water, and held in the hand of some person during the time such water is being used or applied, or by drawing water from such tap into a watering-can or other vessel, and pouring the water therefrom by hand upon such garden or land, and not otherwise, except when the nozzle is one-eighth of an inch or under, when a fixed hose or sprinkler may be used; and any person who uses or applies any such water for the purpose of irrigation, or watering any garden or land in a manner otherwise than provided by this by-law, or who uses such water at any hour of the day or night other than the following, that is to say, from 6 a.m. to 7 a.m., and from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m., shall for every such offence forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding Ten Pounds.

7. The description of piping and apparatus shall be as follows:—Service piping not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch in diameter; service taps not to exceed $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch in diameter.

8. Every person who commits any of the following offences shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Five Pounds; that is to say:—

- (a) Who wastes water supplied by the Trust.
- (b) Who uses water for any purpose other than that for which he is assessed, rated, or charged.

HAMILTON MUNICIPALITY.

A By-law Regulating Traction-engine Traffic.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred on it by "The Local Government Act (Traction-engines), 1907," the Council of the Municipality of Hamilton has made the following by-law:—

1. The fee for the licensing of a traction-engine shall be the sum of Two Pounds for every calendar month between the 1st day of May and the 31st day of October, and the sum of One Pound for every calendar month between the 1st day of November and the 30th day of April.

2. A traction-engine may be used at any time on the main road between Gretna and Ouse, and on no other public street, road, or highway in the said Municipality, unless the owner of such traction-engine has obtained a certificate signed by any three members of the Council, two of whom must be members for the Ward over which the owner intends his traction-engine to travel. In his application for such certificate he shall state his special object in travelling, and the date when he desires to travel. Every such application shall be made to the Council Clerk, who shall submit it to three members of the Council.


