

2. The said Thomas Lancaster Collier died at Hobart aforesaid on or about the twenty fourth day of March One thousand nine -- hundred and eleven without having altered or revoked his said Will which was duly proved by your Petitioner in the Supreme Court of Tasmania in its Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction on the twenty eighth day of August One thousand nine hundred and eleven leave being -- reserved to the said William Michael Hodgman at any time thereafter to come in and prove the same which he has not done up to this date.

100 superficial feet of deal, pine, Oregon, or other softwood shall be deemed to weigh 350 lb. avoirdupois.

Minerals in bags not exceeding 14 inches in length, 10 inches by 6 inches, shall be deemed to weigh 100 lb. avoirdupois.

1 cubic foot of solid building-stone irregularly broken to 2-inch gauge shall be deemed to weigh 118 lb. avoirdupois.

55 cubic feet of green firewood shall be deemed to weigh 1 ton avoirdupois.

80 cubic feet of dry firewood shall be deemed to weigh 1 ton avoirdupois.

1 gallon of liquid shall be deemed to weigh, irrespective of cask, 10 lb. avoirdupois.

1 superficial foot of cast-iron, 1 inch thick, shall be deemed to weigh 37 lb. avoirdupois.

Any member or officer of the Council is empowered to require any driver to stop so as to ascertain the weight of his load.

For the purpose of enforcing any of the provisions of the last preceding section, any member or officer of the Council, or any police officer, is hereby empowered to require the drivers of all loaded vehicles of any description to stop for the purpose of ascertaining the weight of the load thereon; and the refusal of any driver or person in charge of such vehicle to stop when required for this purpose shall be deemed a breach of this by-law. Penalty not exceeding Five Pounds.
