

- I, EDWARD FRANCIS COONEY of Hobart in Tasmania lately a Storekeeper there but now out of business make oath and say as follows:-
- 1. THT for ten years last past I carried on business in Hobart aforesaid as a dealer in General produce until the eighteenth day of June last when I was adjudged bankrupt.
- 2. THAT for over fourteen years prior to and until/the eleventh day of May one thousand nine hundred and fifteen my wife Jessie Margaret Cooney at Hobart aforesaid has carried on business as a grocer and small shopkeeper.
- 3. THAT my wife after advertising her business for sale in both the daily papers published in Hobart sold the same on or about the fourth day of May last.
- 4. THAT on or about the thirteenth day of May last on which day my wife was leaving to visit Melbourne Gustav Adolf Dehle one of the Applicants called at my then place of business when at his request I promised to let my wife know he wished to see her.
- 5. THAT later on in the same day I saw my wife in a nervous and agitated condition on the footway in front of the warehouse of the Applicants when she informed me that she owed them eighty pounds and though she had arranged to pay them eleven pounds per month and had on the eleventh day of May paid them one of such monthly instalments (the receipt for which is now produced and shown to me and marked "A") the said Gustav Adolf Dehle had just then notified her that the Applicants would not let her go out of Tasmania. Up to the moment

that my wife informed me of her indebtedness to the Applicants I was not aware that she was indebted to any person in any amount whatever.

The said Gustav Adolf Dehle referring to the said paper writing said "Just sign this" - I signed it - I did not read it nor did he read it to me, I took it for granted that I was signing an agreement to give security over my Brighton property to save my wife from being put in gool by the Applicants. - At the time I signed the said paper writing my wife had no shop nor premises anywhere she having sold her business as the Applicants then knew.

- 9. THAT neither at the time I agreed to hand to the Applicants the said title deed nor at any other time was mention of any agreement not to put the bailiff into any shop or other premises then or at any other time occupied by my wife.
