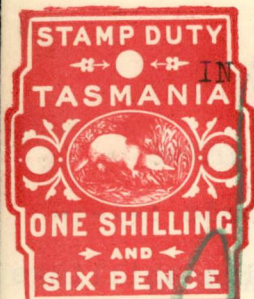

I EDWARD HENRY BUTLER of Hobart in Tasmania Solicitor make Oath and say as follows:-

1. That I am the Public Officer and sole Attorney and Agent of The Colonial Mutual Life Assurance Society in Tasmania.
2. That I am duly authorised by the said Society to make this Affidavit.
3. That on the twenty third day of September one thousand nine hundred and thirteen a Judgment was given in the Supreme Court of Western Australia in favour of the said Society and against the said John Charles Hooper for the sum of four hundred and thirty three pounds seventeen shillings and costs to be taxed in a suit wherein the said John Charles Hooper was Plaintiff and the said Society was Defendant. The said costs were taxed at the sum of one hundred and seven pounds nine shillings and two pence.
4. That on the twenty second day of February one thousand nine hundred and sixteen His Honour Mr Justice Ewing ordered that a Certificate of the said Judgment under the hand of the Master of the Supreme Court of Western Australia dated the nineteenth day of January one thousand nine hundred and sixteen <sup>should</sup> ~~did~~ forthwith be registered in the Supreme Court of Tasmania by the Registrar thereof And that the costs of and incidental to the said registration and of the said Order should be taxed by the Taxing Officer of this Honourable Court and be paid by the said John Charles Hooper.
5. That the said Certificate of Judgment was duly registered in the Supreme Court of Tasmania on the seventh ----- day of March -- one thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
6. That the said costs of and incidental to the said registration and of the said Order were duly taxed by the Taxing Officer of this Honourable Court at the sum of nine pounds twelve shillings and three pence.







7. That the said sums of four hundred and thirty three pounds :-:-:-:-:-  
seventeen shillings for debt one hundred and seven pounds nine shillings  
and two pence for taxed costs mentioned in the said Certificate of :-:-:-  
Judgment and nine pounds twelve shillings and three pence for taxed  
costs as mentioned in the last paragraph hereof making together the sum  
of five hundred and fifty pounds eighteen shillings and five pence was  
still due and owing at the date Execution was issued as mentioned in the  
next paragraph hereof.

8. That on the seventh ----- day of March one thousand nine hundred  
and sixteen execution was issued on behalf of the said Society against  
the goods chattels lands tenements and hereditaments of the said John  
Charles Hooper for the said sum of five hundred and fifty pounds  
eighteen shillings and five pence together with one pound fourteen  
shillings the costs and expenses of the Warrant of Execution making the  
total levy of five hundred and fifty two pounds twelve shillings and  
five pence.

9. That the said Warrant of Execution was returned "No effects".

10. That the said John Charles Hooper is justly and truly indebted to  
the said Society in the said sum of five hundred and fifty two pounds  
twelve shillings and five pence for debt and costs as above set forth.

11. That the said John Charles Hooper resides in King Street Sandy Bay  
in Tasmania within the Southern Electoral Districts.

12. That the facts deposed to in this my Affidavit with the exception  
of those mentioned in Sections 2 and 10 are within my own knowledge.

13. That the facts deposed to in paragraph 2 aforesaid I know from  
perusing the said Certificate of Judgment. And I am informed and verily  
believe the fact deposed to in paragraph 10 aforesaid.

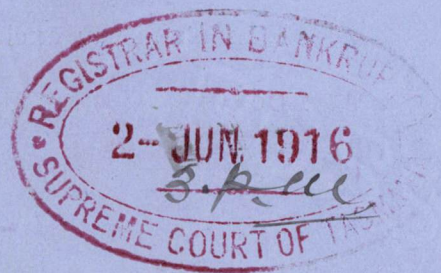

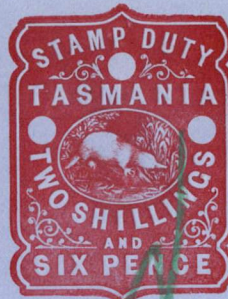
