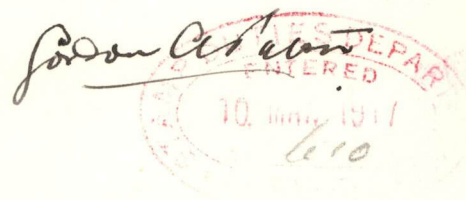
1. That I am one of the members of the firm or copartnership carrying on business at 62 Elizabeth Street Hobart under the style or firm of A. Paton & Son.



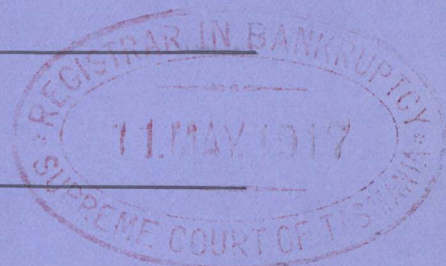
