STATEMENT OF BANKRUPT:-

Until the trouble I had with Bones Bros., about eighteen months ago I was perfectly solvent and in a sound position as a Contractor at Tyenna having eight men in my employment.

I entered into a Sub-Contract about eighteen months or two years ago with O. Bones of Margate to get palings out of the bush at Tyenna for Mr. Joseph Gourlay.

I fed five horses for Bones for three months, found all plant for him and one horse and in the end he drew a cheque from Mr. Gourlay for £141 and got away with the lot including the horse valued at £36 leaving me unpaid.

I met him on the Tyenna Road a few days after this. He was in company with his two brothers. As a consequence of the way Bones had treated me an affray took place and I was subsequently charged before the New Norfolk Police Court with causing grievous bodily harm and presenting fire-arms. I was innocent of the charge and was before the Court about ten times necessitating the attendance of Counsel from Hobart and six witnesses (at 18/- per day each) on each occasion.

I was ultimately committed for trial but no Bill was filed. These proceedings cost me over £300 and my position to-day is due to them.

I am a married man with two children aged nine and five years and now reside at Hobart and have been just about making a living driving for Mr. Riddle and others.

I recently tried to get another start by taking a Contract on the East Coast using Mr. Riddle's horses, but I only just about averaged wages out of it.


