"higher and higher, we do not wish to unduly harass you in any  
"way, but at the same time the account must be reduced in some  
"way. We therefore wish you to call and discuss the matter  
"with us, when, in the event of no satisfactory arrangements  
"being made we regret to say we will be reluctantly compelled  
"to take legal steps for the recovery of the large amount now  
"due to us."

Yours faithfully."

3. THAT the said Frederick Stevens had represented to me  
that there would be sufficient money due to him under the said



Contracts to liquidate his liabilities in connection therewith but I ascertained from The War Service Homes Department two days after the above letter was written that he had misrepresented the facts and there was not the money due and to become due to him under the said Contracts which he had stated. I thereupon sent for the said Frederick Stevens and told him that I had learned that he had - misrepresented the facts which he admitted and I informed him that he would have to liquidate my debt and that I could not further - finance him in connection with the said buildings. I also pointed out to him the seriousness of his misrepresentations and informed him that I could give him no further credit and must insist on my indebtedness being met at once as it was impossible for me to place further reliance in him. The said Frederick Stevens thereupon - urged me to help him complete his Contracts, but I told him this was impossible without security and that there was only one way to secure me and that was by assigning the Contracts. The said Frederick - Stevens agreed to assign and I then made an appointment by telephone with my Solicitor and at the appointed time the above mentioned - Assignment was discussed prepared and eventually signed by both - parties. Prior to the signing of the said document when the matter was being discussed it was arranged that I was to supply all material to complete the said buildings and to pay the said Frederick Stevens the sum of Six pounds per week for his labor in connection with the completion of the said buildings and that I was to take the full - responsibility of seeing that the said buildings were completed - according to the terms of the said Contracts and on my giving an - assurance to the above effect the Assignment was eventually made. Subsequent to the giving of the said Assignment I paid the said - Frederick Stevens for about a fortnight's supervising at the above mentioned figure but after that time he informed me he was no longer prepared to continue and I was thereupon compelled to supervise the buildings myself some of which are completed and others almost so.

4. AMONG the Contracts assigned to me was one which the said Frederick Stevens had entered into with one Otto Koerbin but upon



giving notice of such Assignment to the said Otto Koerbin he refused to recognise the same and insisted upon completing the said Contract himself out of moneys he held on behalf of the said Frederick Stevens. This position I accepted, and as it was not necessary for me to supply any further material or labor in connection with his building I allowed the Trustee to have the benefit of any money due under his Contract.

5. THAT if the buildings had been left in the state they were in at the date of the Assignment to me the Contractees need not have paid any further money under their Contracts as it was only on completion of the said buildings by me in terms of the said Contracts which enabled me to demand payment of the balance of the moneys due thereunder as some of the Contractees informed me they were not prepared to pay any money until I had given them my personal assurance that the buildings would be completed in terms of the Contracts which assurance I gave.

6. THAT if the Contracts had not been assigned to me I am confident that the Trustee would have been advised not to take over the whole (if any) of the Contracts on the ground that such a step would have been too doubtful in the interests of the Estate as the completion of the Contracts would have involved substantial financial obligations.


