





Mr C. Page reads statement of Bankrupt -

Have no bank book & never had  
Have nothing to produce & kept no  
books. Had a bank account at one  
time. Have had nothing to deliver  
to Trustee. I swear to typed statement  
just read by Mr Page which I now  
sign. Dealt with (one BK of Australia)  
- Have not had a pass book except for  
making up income tax return. BK must  
be in BK. Have kept no accounts from  
Auctioneers, destroyed them weeks ago.  
Kept no books showing trading  
transactions. Trading transactions  
during last 3 years were sometimes  
large. Transactions were both thro  
auctioneers and privately. Am not  
married. Lodge at Westalla. Am  
still there and paid board. ~~Had~~  
Had the money with me to pay  
board with. One five weeks board.  
Could not say how much money had  
with me. Can not say within £100.  
I might have had a £100 but not  
within last few weeks. Paid £10  
for board 5 wks ago. Had more  
but not much pay £3 or £4.

About £3 or £4 after paying £10.  
Did not get receipt for board. Have  
no money to pay & must get it from  
some one. Bought 187 sheep from  
Mr McManis.



Roberts & Co November 1920. Did not pay for them & they have since been sold. Buying & selling every week. Do not know if money came to me but think it went into running account. Did not give them any business after sheep bought. Possibly Webster sold them. I suppose money went in general expenses which at times are pretty heavy. Had no money since date of bankruptcy. May have had £4 or £5 but have paid no board. Am not trading & have bought nothing on my own account. Sometimes I get a commission. Have done nothing for myself since 5 Aug. Have had a good part of sale of sheep since November. Money from sheep went into general account & what I had I spent on several things. I gamble on horse races & have lost money. Cannot say where & what amount I lost. Lost a good bit. Say a £10 a day. Do not win often. Can not say result since November of my betting transactions.

Had 60 odd cattle. They were sold at Kironville by Webster. Have no accounts or receipts for money or books. Destroyed accounts when too many in my pockets. Had some stuff at Kironville sale in January, sold by Webster. Do not know if it was a 1000 or not.


