

2. THAT on the twenty fifth day of February last the Debtor filed
a Petition in this Honourable Court for liquidation of his affairs by
arrangement or composition with his creditors and on the twenty third
day of March last a meeting of the creditors of the Debtor was held
when a special resolution was passed by the requisite statutory
majority of the creditors of the Debtor assembled at the meeting that
the affairs of the Debtor be liquidated by arrangement and not in
Bankruptcy and I the said Owen Richmond Tinning was by the same
resolution appointed the Trustee of the affairs of the Debtor.

3. THAT I immediately possessed myself of the whole of the assets
of the Debtor and the same consisted of the said real estate in
Elphinstone Road aforesaid which was subject to two Mortgages to
Doctor Anderson to secure Eight hundred pounds and three hundred
pounds respectively and interest, a Motor Cycle, certain waste timber,
and certain book debts of the debtor and no more all of which I have
since realised upon. After several unsuccessful attempts to dispose
of the said real estate I eventually sold the same for the price of
One thousand six hundred pounds subject to certain payments which was
the best price I could obtain for the same and after discharging the
said mortgage debts and interest and costs and payments as aforesaid
in connection therewith there remains approximately the sum of Four
hundred and forty five pounds or thereabouts. I sold the said
Motor Cycle for the sum of Seventy pounds after several fruitless
attempts to obtain a higher price. The waste timber realised the
sum of Seven pounds ten shillings. The book debts consisted of the
balance of disputed uncompleted contracts for which I realised the
