

1. THAT I am and have for a considerable time past been employed by F. W. Heritage & Co. Proprietary Limited.
2. THAT on the Thirtieth day of June last Charles E Rayner then carrying on business as a storekeeper at Moonah was indebted to the said Company in the sum of One hundred and seventeen Pounds two shillings and ninepence.

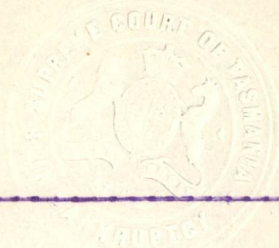
