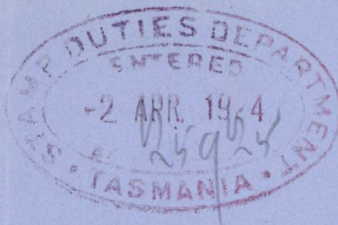

1. That on the Second day of April One thousand nine hundred and twenty four I caused to be filed in the Supreme Court of Tasmania In Bankruptcy a Petition by the said Thomas Daniels for liquidation of his affairs by arrangement or composition with his creditors and on the same day caused to be filed in the said Court an Affidavit in support of such Petition and a request by the said Thomas Daniels that his affairs be liquidated by arrangement or composition with his creditors.
2. That a general meeting of the creditors of the above named person was summoned to be held at the offices of Messrs. Okines & Ogilvie, Collins House, Collins Street, Hobart in Tasmania on Thursday the Twenty fourth day of April One thousand nine hundred and twenty four at Three o'clock in the afternoon.
3. That notices of the said meeting duly sealed with the seal of the said Court were posted to each and every one of the known creditors of the said Thomas Daniels on the Second day of April One thousand nine hundred and twenty four.
4. That a notice of the meeting was published in the Tasmanian Government Gazette on the Eighth day of April One thousand nine hundred and twenty four.

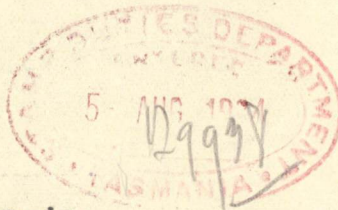
