W E, the undersigned, being the statutory majority of Creditors, assembled at the General Meeting in the above matter duly held at the Office of Messrs W. G. Stephens Smith & Co of 148 Collins Street Hobart this Seventh day of July 1905, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, do hereby resolve as follows:—

(1.) That a composition of Five shillings (5/-) in the pound shall be accepted in satisfaction of the debts due to the Creditors from the said Alice Amelia Phillips

(2.) That such composition be payable as follows:— One hundred pounds to be deposited with Messrs W. G. Stephens Smith & Co on the Tenth day of July instant for division amongst the creditors and a sum sufficient to make up Five shillings in the pound be paid by weekly instalments of three pounds each the first of such instalments to be paid on the twentieth day of July instant such payments to be guaranteed, as provided in clause 3 hereof. In the event of such guarantee being regarded as insufficient the composition be not accepted and that the affairs of the Debtor go into Bankruptcy in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

(4.) That the appointment of a Trustee be left to the Second Meeting of creditors be appointed Trustee in the matter.

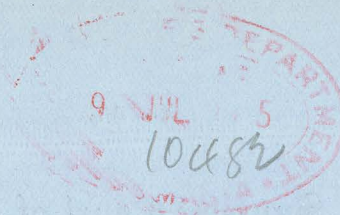
